Aim of the meeting:

The aim of this seminar is to present to the participants the legal situation on the management of end of life vehicles (ELVs) according to the Directive 2000/53/EC, on end of life vehicles and let the participant countries participate in the experience of the Valencia Community, Spain and other Member States in implementing the ELVs legislation.

The most important issues of this seminar, focused mainly on practical experience, are:

- specific legislation implementing problems at a regional and national level;
- reaching the environmental (recovery and reuse) targets set out in Directive 2000/53/EC;
- reporting and monitoring;
- best practices on ELVs treatment;
- post-shredder technologies;
- site visit to an authorised treatment facility (ATF).

Moreover, the participants will have the opportunity to visit ECOFIRA 2008, the International Fair for Water, Soil, Air, Wastes and Their Technologies and Services, and EGÉTICA, the International Energy Efficiency and New Technological Solutions Fair. The synergies between both fairs will play in benefit of a sector with huge potential for growth and which is increasingly to the fore in today's society, calling out for solutions to environmental challenges that are increasingly more pressing.
